The COVID-19 pandemic sheds new light on the tension between federal and state jurisdiction of health law. Sarah Fontenot, Adjunct Professor for Health Law at Trinity University since 1997, will lead participants through the jurisdictional issues in the field. Specific applications include the pandemic crisis, the advancement of independent practice for APPs, the expansion of Medicaid under the ACA, and the decision by some states to allow Physician-Assisted Death. The implications of the looming U.S. Supreme Court case on the constitutionality of the ACA will be addressed and discussed.



**Amer Kaissi, PhD**, is a professor of healthcare administration at Trinity University, San Antonio, where he has taught courses in strategic planning and marketing, healthcare management and human resources management, in addition to directing the school's executive program. Dr. Kaissi is a certified professional executive and

physician coach, advising on business planning and marketing projects, and is a national speaker with the Studer Group. He has published numerous journal articles on leadership, strategic planning and other topics. His most recent publication, *Intangibles: The Unexpected Traits of High-Performing Healthcare Leaders* won the 2019 James A. Hamilton Book of the Year Award.
